News from the Board

I want to take a moment to express a BIG THANK YOU to all the volunteers who have been stepping up during our transition period as we eagerly await the arrival of our new Tennis Director, Daniel Manieri.

As many of you are aware, we have been dealing with plumbing issues in both the men's and ladies' bathrooms. While the ladies' bathroom concerns have been resolved, we are currently addressing the water seepage and broken tile in the men's bathroom. Plans are underway to replace the existing flooring, and we are in the process of obtaining bids for the necessary repairs. We are hopeful that these repairs will be completed soon.

Because we have not received the rains we had hoped for to help maintain our courts, we have implemented additional watering measures to keep the courts in top condition. We are now watering four times a day at 12:45 PM, 8:00 PM, 11:00 PM, and 1 AM to ensure the courts remain moist and playable for all our members.

In addition, we soon will have completed a heavy scarification process on all the courts and added 400 pounds of new material to each court. This new material will help keep the moisture on the playing surface and help prevent the courts from drying out as fast.

We had our season closer Round Robin on Saturday, April 27 with approximately 70 members in attendance. The day was filled with exciting tennis matches, socializing, and a huge taco bar. The silent auction and raffle held during the event raised an impressive \$700 for our capital improvement account. A big thank you to all the volunteers who contributed to making this event a memorable one.

As we bid farewell to our tennis snowbirds who have either departed or will soon be leaving, we wish them safe travels and eagerly anticipate their return.

Thank you once again to all our dedicated volunteers, members, and staff for your unwavering support and commitment to our tennis club. Your contributions make our club, vibrant, welcoming, and truly special.







PlayByPoint (PBP) Tips

Here is this month's PBP tip:

How to Add a Guest User when making a reservation on your phone.

- Select Guest
- Fill in Guest Name and Select Accept
- 3. Select Done

How to Add a Guest User when making a reservation on your computer:


- 1. Select Add Guest User
- 2. Guest will appear
- Select the Edit Pencil and type in the name of the guest and Select Save
- 4. Continue to Book the court

How to reserve a court in 15 minute/half hour increments for courts reserved at 11am:

Via PBP cell phone app-If you want to reserve a court from 11am-12:30pm, select each half hour increment (11-11:30am, 11:30am-12pm, 12-12:30pm), then select the Court #, Next, add players names, Next, Book.

Or once you have selected 11:00am-11:15am, left click on the reservation, hold the clicker down and drag the reservation to where you want the reservation to end. Release the clicker.

Via PBP website-select the time you would like to start (11am in the example on the right), then select "+ Hour" for each additional 15 minutes. Select "Add Booking", Enter player names, Select "Book".
