News from the Board

After reviewing four bids and proposals, we are pleased to announce that we have signed a contract with Superior Fencing & Rail Inc. to replace our broken and rusty fence surrounding courts one through nine. The new fencing will be made of black American steel, secured with 120 pounds of cement footings for enhanced stability and security.

As part of the improvements, we will be extending the fence height to 10 feet along the entire east side of Courts 3, 6, and 9. Additionally, a bottom rail will be installed to prevent future holes in the fence, and the 6-foot fence between courts will be extended to prevent balls from rolling onto adjoining courts. We will also have new gates that close securely.

The total cost for this project is \$101,381.50. While this is a significant expense, the board believes it is necessary for the safety, security, and future of our tennis courts. Given the current condition of the fence, a strong wind could potentially bring down an entire section, so these improvements are crucial.

We are planning to start the project the first week in June, with an anticipated construction period of 4 to 5 weeks, weather permitting.

During construction, we will have 6 courts available, except for 3 to 4 days when the fence between courts one and six is being removed. The project will begin on courts 1, 2, and 3, which should take about four days. After that, they will take down the middle fence, which will require three days to reinstall. During this period, only courts 7, 8 and 9 will be available.

For the entire project duration we should have 6 clay courts available, except for the mentioned days. However, please note that one clay court will be designated as the teaching court, per contract requirements, leaving 5 clay courts available for members throughout June.

We have also discussed staging areas for materials and equipment to ensure minimal disruption to members and our nightly watering schedule will remain unaffected. We will provide you with more information as we get closer to the June project date.

March is going to be a busy month.

First Friday Social: Join us on the first Friday of March for our monthly social gathering.

Annual Meeting and Lunch: Mark your calendars for Saturday, March 8th. We will have lunch followed by our annual meeting right after mixed doubles.

Triples Tournament and Social Event: On Saturday, March 22nd, we will host a new triples tournament, coordinated by Daniel. This will be a fun social event with lunch included. Keep an eye out for more details!

We are excited about these improvements and events.

PlayByPoint (PBP) Tips

Here is this month's PBP tip:

How to Add a Guest User when making a reservation on your phone.

- 1. Select Guest
- Fill in Guest Name and Select Accept
- 3. Select Done

How to Add a Guest User when making a reservation on your computer:


- 1. Select Add Guest User
- 2. Guest will appear
- Select the Edit Pencil and type in the name of the guest and Select Save
- Continue to Book the court

How to reserve a court in 15 minute/half hour increments for courts reserved at 11am:

Via PBP cell phone app-If you want to reserve a court from 11am-12:30pm, select each half hour increment (11-11:30am, 11:30am-12pm, 12-12:30pm), then select the Court #, Next, add players names, Next, Book.

Or once you have selected 11:00am-11:15am, left click on the reservation, hold the clicker down and drag the reservation to where you want the reservation to end. Release the clicker.

Via PBP website-select the time you would like to start (11am in the example on the right), then select "+ Hour" for each additional 15 minutes. Select "Add Booking", Enter player names, Select "Book".



Did you know that you can check the availability of the courts by logging into PlayByPoint and seeing the status of the courts when we have inclement weather? If using your laptop/computer, don't forget to refresh the screen for current updates.



For your information

- ⇒ Every night, PlayByPoint (PBP) is refreshed/updated from the day before. To make sure you have the most accurate and up-to-date information on court playability, be sure your web page or app has been updated or refreshed from the night before.
- ⇒ Also, when PBP does system updates, the always logged on users do not get the update and not having the update can cause the user to be cancelled so that reservations cannot be made. Please log off and on each time you use the system.

MANAGING YOUR FRIENDS LIST ON PBP

You can add players to your Friends list by going to your Directory and clicking on your SEARCH FRIENDS cell. This will take you to your members list. Once in the members list you can click the FOLLOW cell for each member you want to add to your Friends list.

To remove players from your Friends list, go to the members list and click UNFOLLOW for each player you want to remove from your Friends list.

Six of your Friends are displayed below the Find Players cell when you are making reservations and can be added to your reservation by clicking on the ADD cell below your friend's name.

Once names are permanently deleted they will no longer appear on your member list and cannot be UNFOLLOWED or removed from your Friends List.
